<p><u>Task 1: English</u></p> <p>Our class novel this term is 'Street Child', which is set in Victorian times.</p> <p>Find out what school life was like in Victorian times and write a short report about it.</p>	<p><u>Task 2: English</u></p> <p>This term we will look more at using brackets to add information to sentences.</p> <p>Complete the 'Brackets' worksheet.</p>	<p><u>Task 3: Maths</u></p> <p>Solve the chunking problems on the 'Chunking' worksheet.</p> <p>An example is attached, along with squared paper to use for recording work.</p>	<p><u>Task 4: Maths</u></p> <p>Keep practising times tables using Times Table Rockstars every week.</p> <p>Nothing needs to be recorded in homework books for this task.</p>	<p><u>Task 5: Computing</u></p> <p>Make a post on our class blog. It could be a book review, a paragraph about something interesting you did outside of school, or some creative writing of your own!</p>
<p><u>Task 6: Science</u></p> <p>In Science we will be learning about the Earth and Space.</p> <p>Find out about one of the following and write down some facts to share with the class: Black holes, asteroids, constellations or the International Space Station.</p>	<p><u>Task 7: PSHE</u></p> <p>Every Thursday Mrs Taylor will continue working with children on Young Leaders.</p> <p>Children should complete tasks set and bring books in every Thursday.</p>	<p><u>Task 8: Topic</u></p> <p>This term we will be learning about Rivers.</p> <p>Find out about different wildlife living in one of the following rivers: Amazon, Nile, Yangtze or Congo.</p> <p>Either post your findings on the blog or record in your homework book.</p>	<p><u>Task 9: Design Technology</u></p> <p>Later this term children will be learning cooking skills.</p> <p>Start practising at home by cooking or helping out with a recipe. Take a photo and send it to us on Twitter or just write about the experience in your homework book.</p>	<p><u>Task 10: Art</u></p> <p>In Art this term we will focus on the work of JMW Turner.</p> <p>Find out about one of his paintings and try and create your own version. Use paints, felt-tips, crayons or collage!</p>
