<p align="center"><b><u>Task 1: English</u></b></p> <p>Write your own story! This can be about anything you can dream of and can be as short or long as you wish. Make sure to include a clear beginning, middle and end. Each story should include at least 1 question from a character, remember your question marks! I hope to see perfect sentences that each have a capital letter, finger spaces and a full stop or question mark at the end.</p>	<p align="center"><b><u>Task 2: Phonics</u></b></p> <p>Complete the split digraph challenge! Children need to name the object in the picture in the box adjacent to it. Each word will include the split digraph at the top of the column. After completion children should use the back of the sheet to write a minimum of 5 sentences including some of the words they have identified. Please note: Some children are beginning to learn split digraphs on our return to school and therefore may not recognize them all immediately. They will be able to complete this activity as the term progresses.</p>	<p align="center"><b><u>Task 3: Reading</u></b></p> <p>Read for 10 minutes, at least 4 times a week. Make sure that you are reading clearly, sounding out all of the phonemes. Keep this recorded in your Reading Record.</p> <p>Don't forget to upload pictures of you taking great care of your furry friend to twitter!</p>	<p align="center"><b><u>Task 4: Maths</u></b></p> <p>Learn your 5 times tables. Make sure you can count in 5s and multiply by 5! Practice counting in 5s with objects around the home, such as gloves or dried pasta!</p>	<p align="center"><b><u>Task 5: Maths</u></b></p> <p>Help someone cook/bake! Can you use scales to measure the exact amount of ingredients? Can you help an adult figure out how to share your food out equally? For example 12 cupcakes shared between 4 people would mean 3 each! Yum Yum!</p> <p>Don't forget to upload a photograph to twitter showing you using maths to help you!</p>

Draw or paint a picture of Jesus performing your favourite miracle.</p> <p>Be as creative as you can!</p>	<p align="center"><b><u>Task 7: PSHE</u></b></p> <p>Can you design a poster to show the qualities of a good friend.</p>	<p align="center"><b><u>Task 8: Science/Geography</u></b></p> <p>Can you find out where different plants grow? Maybe some countries have different plants to us. Think about the different climates in other countries such as rainforest and deserts!</p>	<p align="center"><b><u>Task 9: Art</u></b></p> <p>Go on a sculpture hunt! When you are out and about see if you can find any sculptures in the area. Can you figure out what the sculpture is made from? Remember to upload a photograph to twitter!</p>	<p align="center"><b><u>Task 10: PE</u></b></p> <p>Can you find a really interesting place to practise your balances? The more exciting the better! Have a go at different types of balances, which was your favourite?</p> <p>Remember to upload a photo to twitter!</p>
