<p><u>Task 1: English / Computing</u></p> <p>Research about life in the Stone Age. Use a dictionary to find the meaning of 5 words you do not know the meaning of.</p> <p>Post your new words onto the class blog at: cccrblogs.net/year32018</p>	<p><u>Task 2: English Spelling</u></p> <p>Find 10 everyday objects in your house. Use the determiner a or an according to whether the next word begins with a consonant or vowel e.g. <i>a rock, an open box.</i></p> <p>Please also practise Y3 Common Exception Words.</p>	<p><u>Task 3: English - Comprehension</u></p> <p>Read the 'Poems about Teachers'.</p> <p>Answer the questions about the poems, make sure you use the poem to find your answers.</p>	<p><u>Task 4: Maths</u></p> <p>Play 3 Sound Check games each week on Times Tables Rock stars.</p> <p>Complete the 8x table multiplication wheel.</p>	<p><u>Task 5: Science</u></p> <p>Draw some 2-D shapes and split them into equal parts. Colour in different sections. How many different fractions can you make using the shapes?</p> <p>Remember: The parts have to be equal in size!</p>
<p><u>Task 6: Science</u></p> <p>Go on a magnetic hunt! Use a magnet to find 6 different magnetic objects.</p> <p>You can tweet a photo of the object which surprised you to be magnetic.</p> <p>*Never put magnets near computers or TV screens*</p>	<p><u>Task 7: RE</u></p> <p>Find a story from the Bible that shows how Jesus changed someone's life. You may like to draw a comic strip or storyboard to retell the story. How do you know Jesus changed their life?</p>	<p><u>Task 8: PSHE</u></p> <p>Make a poster to teach people how to lead a healthy lifestyle.</p> <p>Think about how you stay healthy - include things like diet, exercise, medicines etc</p>	<p><u>Task 9: History</u></p> <p>Stone Age people built shelters using materials they had gathered. Collect some materials from your house/garden and create a mini shelter for a small lego character/doll. Send in a photograph or tweet it!</p>	<p><u>Task 10: Art</u></p> <p>Create a cave painting! Research different cave painting designs and use them as inspiration. Think carefully about the colours and materials they used</p>
