As soon as school receives any additional information or planning for re-opening from the DfE I will be in touch.

The DfE confirmed yesterday that schools will close as usual over the half term holiday and that school meal vouchers will not be available. Any further updates or additional information will be shared directly with effected families.

A huge thank you for all you are doing to support your child. The children continue to amaze us all with their independence, resilience and persistence. Please tweak the remote learning to suit your family needs and the needs of your child as we are all individuals and unique and in fact more special because of that.
