<p><u>Task 1: English</u></p> <p>Begin to learn the Year 2 common exception words. Make sure you are practising writing them neatly, and using them in sentences. If you don't know the meaning; check it in a dictionary or online.</p>	<p><u>Task 2: English</u></p> <p>Draw a picture of a character from a story you are reading. Around the picture, write everything you know about the character. Can you add sentences from the story to prove what you have written?</p>	<p><u>Task 3: Reading</u></p> <p>Read for 10 minutes, at least 3 times a week. Make sure that you are reading clearly, sounding out all of the phonemes. Keep this recorded in your Reading Record.</p>	<p><u>Task 4: Maths</u></p> <p>Learn your 2 times tables. Make sure you can count in 2s, multiply AND divide by 2! Practice counting in 2s with objects around the home, such as pasta or shoes!</p>	<p><u>Task 5: Maths</u></p> <p>Learn all of your number bonds to 100 (60 + 40; 30 + 70 etc.). Make sure you can add to 100, and subtract from 100. Practice counting in 10s first.</p>
<p><u>Task 6: RE</u></p> <p>Retell your favourite Bible story the story through a picture, or a storyboard/comic strip.</p>	<p><u>Task 7: PSHE</u></p> <p>Write 5 things that make a good friend.</p>	<p><u>Task 8: Science</u></p> <p>Go into your (or a relative's) garden and make a list of and draw at least 10 living things you find. Do you know what those living things need to survive?</p>	<p><u>Task 9: Art</u></p> <p>Complete a portrait (a picture) of somebody in your family or a friend. Remember to include as much detail as you can.</p>	<p><u>Task 10: PE</u></p> <p>Try some different exercise and investigate which one makes your heart beat the fastest.</p>
