Spring Term 2019

Welcome back to school, I hope you have had a lovely and peaceful Christmas and New Year. We have a very busy term ahead!

English

We will be starting the term with revision of punctuation and extending our knowledge in this area.



We will be learning how to write a balanced argument, and through this genre we will be learning the art of debate by taking on a role and presenting a view / opinion to an audience.

We will be studying the classic novel, *The Secret Garden* by Frances Hodgson Burnett.

We will study poetry this term and write our own collection of poems based around a familiar theme.

Maths

In Maths we will be looking at number sequences, coordinates, translation and reflection; and revisiting mental and written addition, subtraction, division and multiplication calculations.

We will be learning about statistics, line graphs and pie charts.

Please make sure your child knows their times tables up to 12x12. Every Monday children will be tested on times tables. We will have regular TT Rock Star sessions in school but please encourage your child to 'Rock Out' at home too!

Geography This term we will be learning all about: The Geography of Europe.



Through this topic, the children will be learning to identify and locate countries in Europe and identify the major capital cities of Europe.

Science

Science this term will be 'Animals including humans' and 'Electricity'. We will be having a Bright Spark Electricity Day this term.

PSHE

In PSHE our topic is Emotional Health and Well Being.

Assessments

In Year 6 we have regular written assessments in the style of SATS

papers. Spring Term assessments will be sent home for you to see your child's results.

RE

The children will be celebrating the Eucharist and put their learning into practise by taking part in the whole school Spring Term Eucharist.

The children will develop their knowledge and understanding of Jesus ie: Who was Jesus? Who is Jesus?
