You will notice that this term, your child has 8 tasks to complete rather than 10. With SATS (which I refer to as quizzes) fast approaching, I have reduced the number of tasks, but there is an emphasis on basic skills for the maths and English tasks. All tasks should be ongoing, for example hearing your child read four times per week, including asking questions.

I would like the children to aim to complete **all the tasks** on the grid by **Monday 11th March**. Homework should be handed in on **Mondays only**. There is a grid in the children's homework book representing each task, please date when that task has been completed and feel free to make a comments about how your child found the task.

Many of the tasks should be able to be completed independently, some may require help. Please encourage your child to always present their work to a **very high standard**. If you require any further assistance with the completion of the tasks please do not hesitate to speak to me.

Please note - children need to put the date and number of task at the top of the page before completing the task.
