Science Week

Our Science Week has been a great success, bursting with scientific discoveries! Our week kicked off with a Bright Sparks workshop; when Year 6 spent a jam packed day learning all about the journey of electricity. On Wednesday we explored careers in science and welcomed three guest speakers. Lizzie and Jack, a Nurse and an Operating Department Practitioner from the NHS, visited children in FS, Year 1 and Year 4. They answered the children's questions about what it is like to work for the NHS and orchestrated a 'live operation!' Year 5 and 6 welcomed Kenneth who works in product development at Johnson and Johnson. He taught them all about how Science plays an important part in creating lots of the products we use and depend on every day. Our Year 3 children also attended a Whizz, Bang Science Workshop at Southlands High School on Wednesday where they took part in a range of experiments to explore static electricity. Throughout the week, lots of our children took part in a journey of germs workshop in school, using a special glowing germ simulator to investigate the spread of microbes.
