English

This term our English works shall directly link to different texts. During Summer 1 we shall be studying 'Egyptian Cinderella' by Shirley Climo, to link in with history. After half term we shall read and focus upon 'The Incredible Book Eating Boy' by Oliver Jeffers, which links to our science.

Our class novel shall be The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe.



How to help your child in English.

Ensure your child is reading daily. If they choose to read independently, ask them questions about what they have just read, to ensure they have understanding of the text. This is just as important as the reading itself.


Practise the year 3 and 4 common exception words, these are available on the school website. Please practise these

with you child, place them into context in a sentence.

Maths

In maths we will be continuing to consolidate our place value knowledge. We will also be working with and building upon our use of negative numbers.

We shall be having a big push on fractions and becoming even more confident at using them effectively.



How to help your child in Maths

By the end of year 4 your child needs to know and be confident at all their times tables to 12x12. Please practise times tables regularly with your child, whether this maybe during a car journey or whilst they are washing up.

Your child should be confident at recognising key fraction and decimal equivalents.

$$\frac{1}{2} = 0.5 \quad \frac{1}{4} = 0.25 \quad \frac{3}{4} = 0.75$$

$1/10 = 0.1$ $1/100 = 0.01$

Keep practising these to ensure they are confident at recognising them.

Science

Our science topics are The Water Cycle and Animals, including humans. We shall revisit our knowledge from the autumn term, of evaporation and condensation and understand how this links to the water cycle. After half term, we shall be finding out about key organs in our body and how the digestive system works.



History

Our history topic this half term is all about the Ancient Egypt. We shall be looking into the life of an Ancient Egyptians and

the impact they had on the rest of the world.

Art

In art we shall be looking at the artist L.S Lowry, before creating our own work in his style.

Computing

We will explore databases, discovering why they are useful and ultimately designing our own database.

PSHE

In PSHE our topics are keeping safe and taking risks.

RE

The children will be learning about churches and finding out if they are all the same.
