<p><b><u>Task 1: English- Spelling</u></b></p> <p>Learn the Year 1 and 2 common exception words. I have divided them into groups of 10 words. Start practising Autumn 1 - Week 1 first. This will allow us to work on the same group of words in school!</p> <p>Make sure you are practising writing them neatly, and using them in sentences. If you don't know the meaning; check it in a dictionary or online.</p>	<p><b><u>Task 2:English - Writing</u></b></p> <p>Draw a picture of a character from a story you are reading. Around the picture, write everything you know about the character. Can you add sentences from the story to prove what you have written?</p>	<p><b><u>Task 3: English -Reading</u></b></p> <p>Task 1: Read for 10 minutes, at least 3 times a week. Keep this recorded in your Reading Record.</p> <p>Task 2: <i><b>The Big October Read</b></i> - read as many books as you can in October. Keep a record. <i><b>There will be prizes!</b></i></p> <p>Task 3: <i><b>Y2 Reading Challenge</b></i>. Please see the separate sheet. Deadline July 2023.</p>	<p><b><u>Task 4: Maths - Times Tables</u></b></p> <p><b>Task 1:</b> Times tables are <u>vital</u>. Please complete the 2, 5 and 10 times tables sheets. One sheet is multiplication and the other is division.</p> <p><b>*Please note I will be teaching division during Autumn 1 therefore I recommend completing these sheets in Autumn 2. However, if you'd prefer to get a head start, please feel free. Division can be a tricky concept initially, so if you need any support, please come and see me and I can explain how this is taught in Y2.</b></p> <p><b>Task 2:</b> Complete TTRockstars garage session x2 per week.</p>	<p><b><u>Task 5: Maths - Early Bird</u></b></p> <p>Complete one early bird set per week.</p>
<p><b><u>Task 6: RE</u></b></p> <p>Retell your favourite Bible story the story through a picture, or a storyboard/comic strip.</p>	<p><b><u>Task 7: PSHE</u></b></p> <p>Write 5 things that make a good friend.</p> <p><b><u>Art of Brilliance</u></b></p> <p>Create a photo collage of everything you would like to fill your life with</p>	<p><b><u>Task 8: Science</u></b></p> <p>Go into your (or a relative's) garden and make a list of and draw at least 10 living things you find.</p> <p>Do you know what those living things need to survive?</p>	<p><b><u>Task 9: Art</u></b></p> <p>Complete a portrait (a picture) of somebody in your family or a friend. Remember to include as much detail as you can.</p>	<p><b><u>Task 10: PE</u></b></p> <p>Try some different exercise and investigate which one makes your heart beat the fastest.</p>
