

<p><u>Task 1: English Comprehension</u></p> <p>Read the text on King Midas and answer the questions.</p>	<p><u>Task 2: English Spelling</u></p> <p>Learn the spelling words beginning with F - O on your list of Year 3 Common Exception Words. You only need to practise the words that are not highlighted. Use Spelling Frame to practise other spellings three times per week.</p>	<p><u>Task 3: Maths</u></p> <p>Answer the reasoning questions on written subtraction.</p>	<p><u>Task 4: Maths</u></p> <p>Complete the questions on time. Write the correct time underneath each analogue clock in words. To consolidate your learning, play on Maths Frame. Scan the QR code to access the game.</p> 	<p><u>Task 5: Science</u></p> <p><u>ADULT SUPERVISION REQUIRED</u></p> <p>Investigate the question: Which shoes are best to stop you slipping? Draw a picture of the shoe that is best. Label it to show what it is about that shoe that makes it so good at stopping you from slipping.</p>
<p><u>Task 6: RE</u></p> <p>With an adult, read the story Jesus heals a man born blind. Then, independently cut out each scene from the story and stick them in your homework book in the correct order. If you like, you can colour the pictures once you have finished.</p>	<p><u>Task 7: PSHE</u></p> <p>Learn a new skill! Keep a weekly learning journal of your progress.</p>	<p><u>Task 8: PE</u></p> <p>Create your own obstacle course outside. This could be in your garden, at the park or at a local playing field. What is the quickest time that you can complete your obstacle course in? Can any of your family members beat your time?</p>	<p><u>Task 9: Geography</u></p> <p>The USA is made up of 50 individual states. Use the internet, non-fiction books or your own knowledge to complete the worksheet and name as many of these as you can!</p>	<p><u>Task 10: Art</u></p>  <p>Create a self-portrait in the style of Vincent Van Gogh.</p>
