

# Foundation Stage News Letter

## Summer Term



This term your child will be learning all about On the Farm and Journeys

### PSHE (personal, social and emotional development)

This term the PHSE theme is 'It's OK to Tell'. The children will talk about their feelings and discuss the differences between us all and how we and animals develop and grow.

The children will also be talking about moving to Year 1 and meeting their new teacher. Please help by talking positively about the change to your child.

### English

A stimulus for our writing will be our trip to Bradleys Farm trip. The children will be writing a recount of what they saw and did.

They will be starting their writing with the words first, then, next and last. The children will continue to be encouraged to write in sentences using a capital letter and full stops.

We will be using different picture books as a stimulus for our work during this half term such as 'Dear Zoo and 'What the Ladybird Heard', What the Ladybird Heard Next. .

In Summer 2 the children will be writing letters to Pirates and planning journeys. We will be using the book Train Ride and Pirate Pete and clips from Aladdin as a stimulus.

### PE

Your child will be having PE on **Monday** and **Wednesday**. They will be learning outdoor games, practising our races for sport's day and practising our bat and ball skills. The children will also be having some multi skills sessions.

### Maths

We will continue to discover the numbers 1-20 and consolidating our understanding of them using number bonds and language such as more/ less. We are working on recognising and using money to add and take away. They will use 10p to count in 10s and working how to make 10p in lots of different ways. We will continue to use base 10 and units to make bigger numbers. We are also looking at weight, capacity, money, shape and pattern.



### KUW

We will be going to Bradleys Farm at Rivington alive on a farm and meeting/ feeding animals. We will be learning facts about the animals and talking about babies and their mummies. We will also be looking at how vegetables grow and what they need. Miss Bridge will be starting a gardening club with the children this term. All of the vegetables and salad that is grown is given to the school kitchen to use and we will be entering the Chip in Bloom competition. We will be visiting the church on 17<sup>th</sup> May to talk to Father Andrew about prayer. In RE we will be learning about friendships and what makes a place Holy. We will discover other religions such as Hindu and Muslim beliefs.

### EAD

We will be using different media to create pictures and collages to go with our topic. We will also continue to use junk to make our own models.

We will create large scale models such as a pirate ship and train in our outdoor area.
