POLITE REMINDER

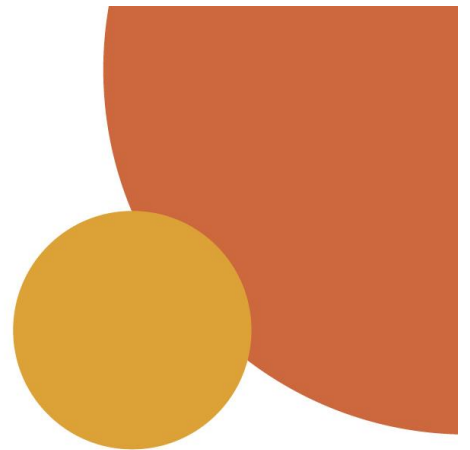
As school starts at 8.55am, classroom doors open at 8:45 am and close at 8.55am. If you are late with your child, please bring them to the main office and sign them in.
